The MusicLink Foundation has established a level of camp scholarship that recognizes MusicLink students from elementary through high school ages who demonstrate high achievement in their musical studies.

The Dorothy B. and Mel Kurzen Endowment is sponsoring an annual camp scholarship for a select MusicLink student seeking a summer experience at a music camp to further his/her musical study. The scholarship provides up to \$1000 to assist a MusicLink student who wishes to attend an extended summer program where tuition fees exceeds our normal \$250 camp scholarship.

Application Deadline: June 1st

ELIGIBILITY: The Dorothy B. and Mel Kurzen Camp Scholarship is available to a student who:

- has been enrolled in the MusicLink program for at least **one year**.
- has a record of progress and commitment to lessons, as indicated on student evaluation forms and by a recommendation letter completed by his/her MusicLink teacher.
- has been accepted into a music camp and applied for possible camp financial assistance.
- includes a CD or video (DVD or YouTube link) demonstrating the recent performance level of the student

5. Please send a CD/DVD or submit a YouTube link demonstrating a sample of current repertoire - two to three pieces of various styles, clearly labeled with student name, composition, and composer.

The teacher recommendation should include information regarding progress in music lessons, overall assessment of student's determination and personal drive as well as achievement in music.
