Grass Roots Grants and Teacher Reimbursements

The Grass Roots Grant program assists alliance organizations and MusicLink teacher studios in providing up to \$500 for new or expanding programs, and specific projects to expand MusicLink opportunities. This year the MusicLink Foundation provided \$3,737.75 to eight alliance partners and teachers in MN, LA, OR, VA, MD and AK. Projects ranged from assisting with piano moves and repairs to community projects and new MusicLink programs in conservatories.

The Teacher Reimbursement Program provides up to \$200 reimbursement for any purchases of music, event fees, instrument repairs or other music expenses for their students each year. This year MusicLink
