The MusicLink Foundation's mission is to provide ongoing lessons at reduced prices for students in need. Often students are without an instrument for these lessons, so we work with donors as well as business partners to bring instruments into the homes of MusicLInk students. Grass Roots Grants

Each year, the MusicLink Foundation provides Grass Roots Grants up to \$500 for teachers and organizations that are expanding their MusicLink programs.

Poolside Jazz Non Profit donates \$1,000 to MusicLink

A group of 8 students at Del Norte High School in San Diego, California formed a jazz band that won a talent competition. They started playing gigs around town, but decided they did not want money they were earning for themselves. Instead, they wanted to pass down the gift of music performance to those less privileged. That is when they found Music Link Foundation and decided it would be the perfect steward of the funds they raised. The students incorporated the band into Poolside Jazz NonProfit, obtained tax-exempt status, opened up a bank account and made their first \$1,000 donation to Music Link Foundation in October 2023. They hope to become an Alliance Partner to Music Link Foundation and get their own website up and running soon.

In Memoriam - Philip Bjorio





The family of Philip Bjorio has chosen the MusicLink Foundation as a worthwhile charity for donations in his memory.

Phil was a life-long pianist and had a passion for helping young adults study piano. He helped organize

and perform concerts to fund scholarships for aspiring students. He took piano lessons his entire life, and most recently studied with Brian Ganz from St. Marys College of Maryland.

Phil was preparing to perform a concert that was scheduled a week after he died. Phil grew up in a Navy family, and 8 of those years were spent in
